Subject: Download and Upgrade of Google Chrome Browser for DCASS Online

Reference is made to the circular dated 15 November 2023 ([CD/OEC/HKCC/306/2023](#)) in relation to the upgrade of Google Chrome browser version for DCASS Online. Currently, the official supporting browser for DCASS Online is Google Chrome version **119.0.6045.106** (“Current Version”).

To align with the update of Google Chrome, Clearing Participants (“CPs”) are required to download the available Google Chrome version from the following link **on 6 May 2024 during 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon Hong Kong Time** (“6 May Version”):

CPs should pay attention to the followings:

1. Circular will be issued to notify CPs when they can start to install this 6 May Version;
2. Prior to installing the 6 May Version, CPs are strongly recommended to backup the Google Chrome installer of the Current Version. By keeping a backup of the previously-verified installer, CPs can ensure that a reliable and stable Google Chrome version is available at all times. This can help to minimize any disruption to CPs’ clearing activities; and
3. **CPs may not be able to login DCASS if the Google Chrome version of their DCASS Online are not complied with HKEX’s requirement as prescribed from time to time.**
