On-boarding Arrangements for Derivatives Lite ("D-Lite")

References are made to the circulars dated 11 July 2017 (Ref: <u>MDD/002/2017</u>), 12 October 2017 (Ref: <u>MDD/003/2017</u>) and 26 October 2017 (Ref: <u>MDD/004/2017</u>) regarding the introduction of the D-Lite for Participants of Hong Kong Futures Exchange Limited and Participants of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited trading Stock Options (collectively Exchange Participants, or EPs) and the on-boarding arrangement detailed in the <u>Market Data Briefing in July 2017</u>.

We would like to inform you that the Market Rehearsal (MR) for the rollout of D-Lite is scheduled for 24 March 2018 tentatively. Applicants planning to receive D-Lite production data upon its target rollout in April 2018 through *direct connection* ("Direct Connection Applicants") are required to pass the MR and should take note of the following arrangements:

(A) <u>Readiness of the Production Lines for Connection to D-Lite</u>

Direct Connection Applicants must have their production lines ready before the MR and should place order to their selected Network Carrier for production line installation / reconfiguration as soon as possible. Please also return the <u>OMD Production Connection Notification Form</u> with required details to HKEX-IS **on or before end of December 2017**.

(B) <u>Completion of Market Data Licence Application</u>

Direct Connection Applicants must have their market data licence application completed by returning the duly signed Market Data Vendor Licence Agreement or Market Data End-User Licence Agreement to HKEX-IS by two days before the MR (i.e. 22 March 2018).

(C) Declaration of Readiness for Joining MR

Direct Connection Applicants are required to declare their readiness status by submitting the following materials to HKEX-IS before they can participate in the MR. The requirements depend on the type of licence applied, the software used to connect to D-Lite and whether access to the Retransmission Service (RTS) is needed.
