Subject: **HKATS and DCASS Upgrade to Genium INET Platform – Updated HKATS User’s Guide, Installation and Practice Sessions of CLICK Trade software (v1.14.4.43)**

Reference is made to the circular (ref: DMD/083/13) dated 30 May 2013. Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited (“HKEx”) plans to upgrade the Hong Kong Futures Automated Trading System (“HKATS”) and the Derivatives Clearing and Settlement System (“DCASS”) from Release 19.1 to the Genium INET Platform.

We are pleased to inform Exchange Participants (“EPs”) that the pilot installation of the new CLICK Trade software has been completed successfully and the street-wide installation will commence from 27 June 2013. EPs are required to install the new CLICK Trade software and perform the following items:

1. Download the installation package of the new CLICK Trade software (v1.14.4.43) from Electronic Communication Platform (“ECP”) (<https://www.ecp.hkex.com.hk>). If needed, EPs may request for an installation CD-ROM through the HKATS Hotline.
2. Read through the “CLICK Trade Installation Guide” (“Installation Guide”) which is available in the installation package and follow exactly the installation guide to perform the installation of the new CLICK Trade software **on or before 19 July 2013**. Upon installation finished, please complete and return the attached confirmation form as set out in Appendix 1 to HKEx by fax (2509 0724 or 2877 0017) or by email ([ClickSupport@hkex.com.hk](mailto:ClickSupport@hkex.com.hk)).
3. In order to facilitate EPs to test the connectivity of the new CLICK Trade software, HKEx will arrange Connectivity Tests on 27 July 2013, 3 August 2013 and 10 August 2013 respectively.
4. After completing the installation, EPs should not use the new CLICK Trade software (v1.14.4.43) to logon HKATS other than the subsequent Connectivity Tests, Production Readiness Tests and Market Rehearsals. The new CLICK Trade software should not be able to assess the HKATS 19.1 production environment.
