I oppose because the proposals will erode Hong Kong's status as a leading international financial center due to the concentration of power in one institution without the necessary checks and balances.

Under the Proposed New Structure, power would be concentrated in few hands under control of SFC which is regulator – minded. This mindset will tend to protect the regulator by shutting off the door to many companies, or raising the threshold to such high level that less and less listings will be attracted to Hong Kong. This would compromise Hong Kong's position as an international financial center.
