Consultation Paper on Review of Listing Rules relating to Disciplinary Powers and Sanctions

We have today published a consultation paper on the Review of Listing Rules relating to Disciplinary Powers and Sanctions (**Consultation Paper**).

The Consultation Paper follows a wide-ranging review of the Exchange's disciplinary powers and sanctions under Chapter 2A of the Listing Rules, to ensure that the disciplinary regime remains robust and effective.

The Consultation Paper seeks comments on a number of proposals and enhancements, with a particular emphasis on strengthening the Exchange's powers to hold accountable, and impose appropriate sanctions on, individuals responsible for misconduct and Listing Rule breaches.
