We believe that it would be helpful for the Exchange to specify more clearly the level of detail they require in respect of the financial information. This could be specified by reference to at least the content required to be included in an interim financial report properly prepared in accordance with Hong Kong/International Accounting Standard 34 "Interim financial reporting" issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants/International Accounting Standard Board, if the Exchange does not want to require full financial statements in accordance with Hong Kong/International Financial Reporting Standards. In the absence of such guidance it may be difficult for the auditors or reporting accountants to express an opinion or conclusion on the information.

On Page 6 of the Consultation Paper, the Exchange expresses the view that it envisages an accountants' report may be preferred for issuers electing to disclose financial information under (a) in Paragraph 15 on Page 5 of the Consultation Paper where the reporting period end coincides with the issuer group's financial year end. If true, it would be helpful to clarify that the Exchange is not expressing a preference for either an accountants' report or a review report under either approach (a) or (b) and that it is for the issuer to determine the most appropriate form of the information in each situation.

In connection with the statement by the directors on any material adverse change, the issuer may need to issue a modified statement, taking into account the effect of the disposal. More specific guidance on reporting the impact of the disposal as part of the statement on material adverse change in the financial or trading position of the issuer's group may be helpful.
