We would also like to take this opportunity to recommend increasing the minimum board independence level to majority independence - this is especially important for issuers without an independent board chair to have an effective counterbalancing mechanism. For example, in India, at least 1/2 of the board is required to be independent when the chair is not independent.

While we prefer issuers to transition as soon as possible, we are conscious of the need to ensure overall board continuity during the transition period so we would strongly encourage issuers to plan ahead of time and avoid abrupt large changes to the Board at the end of the three-year transition period.
