Subject: VaR Platform (formerly known as NGRM) Familiarisation Programme Phase 2 –

Reference is made to the circular dated 27 July 2021 (Reference: <u>CD/CDCRM/218/2021</u>) regarding the commencement of Familiarisation Programme Phase 2 of VaR Platform (formerly known as NGRM). Clearing Participants (CPs) should have started to retrieve and study their own Default Fund¹ (DF) Contribution analysis reports² calculated based on their own portfolios, as well as the one-off Initial Margin analysis reports.

Hong Kong Securities Clearing Company Limited (HKSCC) is pleased to announce that, with Phase 2, the Familiarisation Programme will be enriched with the following additional features:

(i) Starting from 27 September 2021:

CPs can access VaR Online for margin and stress testing simulations.

(ii) Starting from 4 October 2021:

• CPs can retrieve the following reports from Report Access Platform (RAP):

 a. updated DF Contribution analysis reports from May to September 2021 calculated based on their own portfolios;

b. intra-day margin estimation reports, and margin related supporting information, including corporate action event report, series price report, IPO indicator report and

margin multiplier report;

c. DF Requirement Reports, including stress testing report;

- d. Mainland Settlement Deposit (MSTD) and Mainland Security Deposit (MSCD) reports; and
- e. Initial Margin Risk Parameter File and Stress testing Risk Parameter Files (only available for those CPs subscribed for RPF folder).

CPs can make reference to the Report Comparison Guidelines which are available on <u>HKEX website</u> when they study the new reports. Please refer to the <u>VaR Platform Familiarisation Programme</u> <u>Information Package</u> for more details of the Familiarisation Programme.

It is important for CPs to understand the new risk models and the potential changes on their initial margin and DF requirements. Please note that the one-off Initial Margin analysis reports and the updated DF Contribution analysis reports are available for retrieval via RAP and CPs are strongly encouraged to study those reports to prepare for the launch of VaR Platform.

HKSCC will host webinar briefings on the latest updates, operational timeline under new risk model and key features of VaR Platform in October 2021. CPs should register via the Event section in Client Connect on or before 11 October 2021. Details of the briefings are as follows:

CPs therefore should not rely on the VaR Platform or any output from such platform in any way and should continue their normal risk management measures, prepare funding and make payments according to existing



CCASS reports and schedule until the business implementation of the VaR Platform and the new risk models.
