Reference is made to Exchange Circular (Ref: MSM/008/25) regarding the Publication of Northbound Program Trading Reporting Guidelines ("the Guidelines") by Shanghai Stock Exchange ("SSE") and Shenzhen Stock Exchange ("SZSE") on 11 July 2025.

In order to facilitate China Connect Exchange Participants' ("CCEPs") and Trade Through Exchange Participants' ("TTEPs") understanding on the Guidelines and northbound program trading related surveillance arrangements and monitoring practices, HKEX has coordinated two seminars to be conducted by the SSE and SZSE surveillance teams on 15 September 2025 and 17 September 2025. These seminars are open to all CCEPs and TTEPs only.

As seats are limited, enrolment will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. The registration deadline is Friday, 29 August 2025. Please refer to the Appendix for enrolment details.
