GENERAL

COMPOSITION, POWERS, FUNCTIONS AND PROCEDURES OF THE GEM LISTING COMMITTEE, THE LISTING APPEALS COMMITTEE AND THE GEM LISTING DIVISION

Appointment and removal of members of the GEM Listing Committee

3.26 Members of the GEM Listing Committee may only remain in office for a maximum of 3 consecutive years. Any person who serves as the Chairman or the Deputy Chairman of the GEM Listing Committee may remain in office for a total of 4 years. A member (including the Chairman and Deputy Chairman) who has served for the maximum period permitted by this rule may be eligible for re-appointment after the lapse of 2 years from the date on which he last vacates office. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in exceptional circumstances, the Listing Nominating Committee shall have the discretion to nominate a person for re-appointment at any time before the lapse of within a period shorter than 2 years from the date such person he vacates office but not shorter than 1 year from such date and the Board shall have the power to appoint such person.
