Reminder of Severe Weather Trading

With reference to our Client Notice issued on 16 September 2024 (Our Ref: [MDD/24/562](#)) and 10 June 2025 (Our Ref: [MDD/25/286](#)), Severe Weather Trading ("SWT") has been effective since 23 September 2024.

Trading of securities and stock options at The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited, including Northbound and Southbound Trading under Stock Connect, and trading of derivatives contracts at Hong Kong Futures Exchange will remain available¹, and all market data systems will be operating as usual as regular trading day during severe weather ("SW") conditions².

Clients and ISVs are reminded to review your systems and operational arrangement for SWT.

HKEX will make relevant announcements as required, to provide the market with advanced notice and updates
