- a. In case Typhoon Signal No. 8 or above or Extreme Conditions or Black Rainstorm Warning is issued/ announced or continues to be in force anytime from 13:00 to before 15:00 on the day of PRT, the PRT will be cancelled and will not be resumed for the rest of the day.
- b. In case Typhoon Signal No. 8 or above or Extreme Conditions is issued on or after 15:00 on the day of PRT, the PRT will be terminated 15 minutes thereafter.
- c. In case Black Rainstorm Warning is issued on or after 15:00 on the day of PRT, the PRT will continue until completion.
